

Job Costing & Tracking

COSS allows your company to access the right information at the right time. By providing you with access to real-time job status and online shipping reports, COSS opens the door to improved customer service and communication. Information can be viewed in detailed and summary formats, giving you a range of reports to stay on top of your business. COSS's main objective is to provide relevant reporting when you require it – equipping you with the management control system you need to run your business.

FEATURES

- Online updates from the shop floor deliver real-time job costs and tracking. This information is available to the customer service department.
- Data can be collected in real-time off the shop floor or entered manually through time cards.
- Single-screen checking allows you to view the status of jobs and time remaining at each operation.
- Job status can be viewed as a Gantt chart by customer, project, or part type, depicting quantity completed and currently in WIP.
- Job costing is updated directly from the Accounts Payable module for any purchases made directly for the job.
- Costing out of jobs can be done using either of two methods, depending on the cost driver that is set. The cost driver can be set to either machine hours or employee hours depending on requirements.
- Overhead rates can be set by machine hour or as a percentage of labor worked.
- Operational note tracking stores pertinent data based on inspection and records all issues pertaining to the operation. These notes are stamped with the date, time and name of the operator who recorded the data.
- Parameters built into costing allow you to accommodate one employee working on multiple machines simultaneously.
- Job costing is supported at the weighted average, standard or the actual cost if purchased directly for job.
- Work-in-progress reporting, in both detailed and summary formats, allows you to value the job at any stage of production, providing you accurate WIP value for the balance sheet.
